Offer technical assistance, tools, and coaching to enhance grantees' internal capacity to independently pursue funding opportunities in the future.

An estimated budget with fee structure (hourly, project-based, or retainer), along with any anticipated expenses.

Contact information for at least two past clients or partners familiar with your grant writing and fund development work.

Name, title, organization (if applicable), phone number, email, and website (if available).
